<p>Writing to entertain:</p> <p>To write a historical story.</p>	<p><i>With a focus on The Romans and their impact upon Britons, children will write their own legend about the Celt rebellion of Boudicca.</i></p> <p>Write a short story set in Roman times about a slave who travels from Europe to Britain. Use Empire's End /Escape from Pompeii. Children will aim to write:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Using expanded noun phrases to provide detailed descriptions of character and setting• With adverbials of how and when• Including full punctuation for direct speech
