<p>Writing to inform:</p> <p>To understand the different genres: <b>fiction</b> and <b>non-fiction</b></p>	<p>By Reading James and the Giant Peach we will be exploring the different genres to create an information booklet.</p> <p>Children will aim to write:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• In third person</li><li>• Using subheadings to label content – key features</li><li>• In paragraphs to organise information</li><li>• Using present tense</li></ul>
<p>Writing to entertain:</p> <p>To write a historical story.</p>	<p><b><i>With a focus on The Romans and their impact upon Britons, children will write their own legend about the Celt rebellion of Boudicca.</i></b></p> <p>Write a short story set in Roman times about a slave who travels from Europe to Britain. Use Empire's End /Escape from Pompeii. Children will aim to write:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Using expanded noun phrases to provide detailed descriptions of character and setting</li><li>• With adverbials of how and when</li><li>• Including full punctuation for direct speech</li></ul>
