

Objective

In EYFS, children learn English skills through a variety of strands. One of these, being communication and language. This is broken down further into listening & attention and understanding. Within the physical development area of learning, 'English' is taught through the development of fine motor skills in which children hold a pencil effectively in preparation for fluent writing – using the tripod grip in almost all cases. This comes through experience and practice.

The literacy area of learning is broken down into 3 different strands: Comprehension, word reading and writing.
