

Vocabulary	Definition
Traditional Tale	A story that has been retold over many years. Sometimes called a fairy tale.
Setting	Where a story takes place, such as a castle.
Plot	It describes the events that make up a story. There is often a sequence of events.
Character	A person or animal in a story.
Fable	A short story that has a moral .
Hero	The main character in a story. A hero Is usually a character who is good.
Villain	The character who is the opposite of the hero. The villain could be mean.
